CONTINUITY

- 1. It takes all three Persons of the Holy Trinity to save a person
- 2. Holy Spirit sanctifies (makes us holy) through the Word of God
- 3. Holy Spirit imparts diverse Spiritual Gifts at conversion.
- 4. Holy Spirit imparts Fruit of the Spirit in different degrees guides using gifts.
- 5. Holy Spirit inspired (God breathed) the Scriptures (inspire, inerrant)

INTRODUCTION

- A. REDEMPTION OF CHRIST is distributed through the Means of Grace.
 - 1. THE WORD OF GOD (Spoken, Written, Digital, Visible, Incarnate)=
 - 2. THE SACRAMENTS
 - a. Greek μυστήριον (mysterion) means 'mystery'
 - b. Latin translation of Greek *mysterion*: SACRAMENTUM
 - c. <u>1 CORINTHIANS 4:1</u> This is how one should regard us, as servants of Christ and **stewards of the mysteries of God**.
 - d. Define 'sacraments' according to *decreed ordinances* in the Word.
- B. Definition of a *Sacrament* (1 Corinthians 4:1)
 - 1. Sacred action [something is conveyed not just words]
 - 2. Instituted by God [divine initiation]
 - 3. Visible elements from the world
 - 4. Word and Command of God behind it [Go and Baptize! Do this often!]
 - 5. Promises and Gives the Forgiveness of Sins
- C. Two sacraments fit this biblical (not philosophical) definition
 - 1. Holy Baptism
 - 2. Lord's Supper

I. WHAT IS BAPTISM?

- A. WATER connected to God's Word and Direct Command
 - 1. <u>MATTHEW 28:19</u> Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them **in(to)** the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit ...

- 2. Therefore, water baptism is not OPTIONAL to our salvation.
- 3. SACRAMENT OF ENTRANCE into God's Family [the Christian Church].
- 4. Baptism is the *external sign* of what happens *internally* [cleansing of sin].
- 5. GOD'S WORD connected to the Water is the power of baptism.

a.1 CORINTHIANS 6:11

- b. <u>TITUS 3:5-</u>7
- c. <u>MARK 16:16</u> Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned.
- 6. Adult Baptism *seals* the promise of forgiveness to the adult individual.
- 7. INFANT BAPTISM causes the forgiveness and salvation of the
- 8. One can *fall* from baptismal grace by rejecting Word and Promise of Christ.
- 9. The mode of water application is NOT the issue is water baptism.

a. **ROMANS 6:1-**4

- **b.** $Ba\pi\tau i \zeta \omega$ includes immersion, sprinkling, pouring washing
- 10. Valid Baptism: WATER + WORD OF PROMISE + NAME OF TRIUNE GOD
- 11. Sponsors (Lutheran Christians) and Witnesses (Non-Lutheran Christians)

B. THE ISSUE OF **INFANT** BAPTISM

- 1. Infants are sinful (Romans 6:23 and Psalm 51:1-5).
- 2. Infants can believe in Jesus as Lord and Savior (Ephesians 2:8-9)

C. OLD TESTAMENT ROOTS OF HOLY BAPTISM

- 1. <u>GENESIS 17:9-14</u> (Law of Circumcision at 8-days old)
- 2. <u>COLOSSIANS 2:9-12</u> (Baptism replaces Circumcision)
- D. BAPTISM MUST BE CONTINUED THROUGH INSTRUCTION IN THE WORD.
 - 1. Baptism saves but it is not a magical guarantee of heaven.
 - 2. INFANT BAPTIM *initiates* a saving relationship with God but that relationship can be severed by neglect or despising of the Word and Sacraments.
