# Unit 1701: The Disciple as Missionary Under Authority of Christ - Part 2 Matthew 10:1-42

#### **CONTINUITY FROM LAST SESSION (October 27, 2024)**

- 1. Ten consecutive miracles reveal the authority of the Christ > demand obedience.
- 2. The Life of the Flesh is in the Blood (Leviticus 17:11).
- 3. Jesus fulfills Old Testament Messianic Prophecy: Preach, Teach, Heal
- 4. Jesus exercises authority with COMPASSION (splanghnah)
- 5. Harvest of Lost Souls is plentiful but laborers are few Pray for God to send more.
- 6. The CALL OF THE 12 TWELVE DISCIPLES is also OUR CALL TO DISCIPLESHIP!

#### I. THE NAMING OF THE TWELVE APOSTLES - Matthew 10:1-4

- 1. 12 is a SYMBOLIC NUMBER (12 Tribes and 12 Disciples) Number of Church
- 2. Jesus conveys His authority to the 12 Disciples (The Church).
- 3. Twelve names with a unique history (Peter first Judas last)

#### 4. ACTS 12:1-2

# II. JESUS SENDS OUT THE TWELVE APOSTLES (Matthew 10:5-15)

- 1. Greek verb ἀποστέλλω (sent forth) has the same root as ἀπόστολος (apostle one who is "sent forth or out").
- 2. We believe in ... one holy and apostolic church [Church is sent out].
- 3. Jesus' first commitment is to the <u>People of Israel</u> NOT the Gentiles.
- 4. Genesis 12:1-3
- 5. Ministry of Jesus ushers in the Kingdom of God (Matthew 4:17 and 3:1-2)
- 6. Jewish traditional greeting: SHALOM [שַלוֹם] generally "peace"
- 7. SHALOM SAYS: May the best that God can possibly give come forth for you!
- 8. Shake off the dust from your feet ... is a GESTURE OF SEVERANCE.

## III. THE APOSTLES WILL FACE PERSECUTION (Matthew 10:16-24)

- 1. Jesus asserts His AUTHORITY in an emphatic way.
- 2. The mission will be difficult and dangerous (Matthew 7:15).
- 3. Wisdom (serpent) and Innocence (Dove) required for the mission.
- 4. The disciple will relive the experiences of Christ (persecution, betrayal, hatree
- 5. Persecution will not stop or discourage witness but create opportunity!
- 6. Beelzebul is the Prince of Demons, whom Jesus identified as Satan
- 7. See Matthew 12:24, Mark 3:22-23 and Luke 11:15-19

#### IV. DISCIPLES HAVE NO FEAR WHEN SENT INTO MISSION (Matthew 10:23-26)

- 1. No need to be afraid of three things:
  - \* Fear of Persecution (26)
  - \* Fear of God's judgment on disobedience (28)
  - \* Fear of whether or not God cares (31)
- 2. Bring MAXIMUM ATTENTION to the witness of Christ (Matthew 5:1)
- 3. Acknowledge Christ before men or not be acknowledged before God.

# VI. JESUS BRINGS A SWORD (SEPARATION) - NOT PEACE (Matthew 10:34-39)

- 1. Christ has come to separate humans from unbelief and evil.
- 2. Those who try to save their PHYSICAL LIFE will lose ETERNAL LIFE.
- 3. But those who lose their PHYSICAL LIFE FOR Christ's sake discover that they have found ETERNAL LIFE.

### VII. CHRIST GIVES REWARDS TO FAITHFUL DISCIPLES (Matthew 10:40-42)

- 1. Christ identifies the disciple with Himself then Himself with the Father.
- 2. Four SERVANTS: Christ, Prophet, Righteous (Wo)Man, Disciple. Verse 40-41 -
- 3. God watches over ALL HIS SERVANTS and will REWARD even the smallest kindness (cup of cold water to a child) shown to a seeking person.
