# To Be a Disciple

## *Unit 701: From Baptism to Temptation to Calling Disciples* Matthew 3:13-4:22

#### CONTINUITY FROM LAST WEEK

- 1. John's Message: Repent! Kingdom of God [Heaven] is here!
- 2. John's baptism was a *Baptism of Repentance* and *Identification with Christ*.
- 3. The Coming One [Christ] will baptize with The Holy Spirit [Trinitarian] and Fire [Judgment of Separation].
- 4. Jesus launches his Public Ministry [Age 30-33] at his baptism by John [anointed with the Holy Spirit].

#### A. THE SIGNIFICANCE OF THE BAPTISM OF JESUS (Matthew 3:13-17)

- 1. Location: Qasr-el Yahud (E Jordan) or Bethany (W Jordan)
- 2. Purpose: *To fulfill all righteousness* mot cleanse from sin
- 3. Full Trinitarian Baptism Holy Spirit central
- 4. Empowerment of Jesus' human nature
- 5. Psalm 2:6-8
- 6. Isaiah 42: 1,6

#### **B. THE TEMPTATION OF JESUS (Matthew 4:1-11)**

- 1. Cosmic confrontation of good and evil was planned by God!
- 2. Temptation will take place in the *wilderness* [domain of Satan].
- 3. Jesus has been fasting forty days and forty nights.
- 4. Symbolic number 40 (new life, new growth, transformation)
- 4. Matthew 6:16-18
- 6. Common thread: Use your divine resources to skip the Cross
- 7. The power of the memorized Word
- 8. The Defeat of Satan

OLD ADAM	NEW ADAM (Christ)
Created	Born of a Virgin
Tempted	Tempted
Fell into Sin	Didn't Fall into Sin
Brought Death	Brought Life
Sought Equality with God	Didn't seek Equality with God

#### C. THE BEGINNING OF JESUS' GALILLEAN MINISTRY (4:12-17)

- 1. John was arrested BEFORE Jesus began his Public Ministry.
- 2. Jesus' ministry headquarters in Capernaum.
- 3. The Old Israel [Elijah/John] and the New Israel [Jesus] are carefully marked off from each other. (See Isaiah 9:1-2)
- 4. Content of Jesus' preaching is identical to John's preaching.
- 5. KINGDOM OF HEAVEN = God's rule in the hearts and lives of people TODAY

#### IV. THE CALLING OF THE FIRST DISCIPLES (Matthew 4:18-22)

- 1. What is the meaning of the word DISCIPLE?
  - 1. G\_\_\_\_\_ 2. G\_\_\_\_\_ 3. G\_\_\_\_\_ 4. G\_\_\_\_\_ 5. G\_\_\_\_\_ 6. G\_\_\_\_\_ 7. G

2. Jesus chooses and calls his own disciples (not the opposite).

3. Immediacy of the call to obedience [without delay] – See John 15:16

- 11. When we are tempted and tried, what does our discipleship suggest to us?
