Unit 901: Jesus Shapes the Will of the Disciple

Matthew 5:1-20

CONTINUITY FROM LAST WEEK

- 1. Jesus first act in Public Ministry is calling of disciples to Himself.
- 2. Jesus calls disciples and us we do not choose Jesus; He chooses us.
- 3. Identified the 7 G's of contemporary discipleship (Grace, Growth, Gifts, Giving, Gathering, Groups, Going).
- 4. Since we are all "works in progress", keep the Gospel Motivation in our discipleship.
- 5. The *Sermon on the Mountain* exposes how Jesus *trained his disciples* (and us) to live a New Life with a New Righteousness in the Kingdom of God.
- 6. Critical to stop reading Matthew as a History Book to be Believed.
- 7. Matthew is a LIVING BOOK that calls us to a LIVING DISCIPLESHIP (The Words have consequences that call us into immediate action).

I. THE SERMON ON THE MOUNT [Be-Attitudes] 5:1-11

- A. MOUNTAINS ... places of great events and divine revelations
- B. SITTING ... posture for preaching and training
- C. Initial section of Sermon on Mount called BE-ATITUDES
 - 1. Beatitudes 1-4 pronounce blessing on those who have nothing and need everything
 - 2. Beatitudes 5-8 deal with the final judgment and the new world that God will create.
- D. Greek μακάριος = blessed, happy at receiving God's fav
 - 1. poor in spirit (repentant and dependent) ... Isaiah 66:2)
 - 2. those who mourn (long for comfort over sin) ... Isaiah 61:1-2
 - 3. the meek (humble and trusting God for mercy ... Psalm 37:11
 - 4. *hunger and thirst for righteousness* (know sin and craving righteousness ... Jeremiah 23:5-6
 - 5. *merciful* (patient, gentle, understanding, forgiving)
 - 6. pure in heart (undivided, single-hearted loyalty)
 - 7. peacemakers (bring peace to the Body) ... Isaiah 9:6
 - 8. persecuted for righteousness sake (ridiculed or killed) ... Matthew 20:28

II. THREE IMAGES OF NEW LIFE IN THE KINGDOM OF GOD (Matthew 5:13-16)

- A. You are the **salt** of the earth (preserve from judgment)
- B. You are the *light* of the world (shining good works lead to faith)
- C. You are a city set on a hill (visible for all to see)

III. THE DISCIPLE AND HIS RELATIONSHIP TO THE LAW (Matthew 5:17-20)

- A. the Law and the Prophets ... standard Jewish name for entire Old Testament.
- B. PERFECT LOVE is the fulling of the Law (for God and the Neighbor)
- C. First Table (Commandments 1-3) ... Matthew 25:35-38
- D. Second Table of the Law (Commandments 4-10) ... Matthew 22:39-40
- E. True disciples view the Law through the Cross of Jesus Christ.
