Lesson 2: The Person who Calls Disciples Fulfills Seven Prophecies Matthew 1:18-2:12

INTRODUCTION

- A. Matthew 1:7-17: Note the dynamic (seismic) shift in Jesus genealogy.
 - 1. From now on, Jesus' genealogy is traced through KINGS of JUDAH.
 - 2. Jesus Messiah is THE royal descendant of King David in Old Testament.
- B. MATTHEW 1:17 17 Thus there were fourteen generations in all from Abraham to David, fourteen from David to the exile to Babylon [597 BC], and fourteen from the exile to the Messiah.
 - 1. 14 days for the moon to rise to apex and fall?
 - 2. Numerical value Hebrew name David [קוד] totals 14?
 - 3. 7 x 2 (7 is number of COMPLETION in Scripture)?
 - 4. APPLICATION: Jesus COMPLETELY FILLS UP the hopes and dreams
- C. THE BIRTH OF JESUS THE MESSIAH (1:18-25)
 - 1.. Joseph is NOT the source of Jesus' humanity.
 - 2. Breaking the 'chain link fence' of Original Sin
 - 3. Hebrew name *Joshua* [יהושוע] means *Yahweh* saves.
 - 4. Greek name for Joshua is Ἰησοῦς (One who saves)
 - 5. Jesus-Messiah fulfills seven Old Testament Prophecies (completion)

II. THE VISIT OF THE WISE MEN (Matthew 2:1-12)

- A. MESSIANIC SIGN that was predicted in the Old Testament (Hebrew Bible).
 - 1. Wise men not kings, despite extravagant gifts but astrologers, presumably from Persia or Babylon ... men who worked for a king.
 - 2. Misleading: We three kings of Orient Are
- B. Hebrew הַּעַלְמָה (almāh) means "marriageable young woman"
 - 1. But *Septuagint* (Greek translation of Hebrew Old Testament) translates *almāh* as $\pi\alpha$ οθένος (virgin maid).
 - 2. Wise Men knew that Messiah was referred to as *Star of Jacob* [Numbers 24:17].
 - 3. STAR was probably a conjunction of the planets Saturn and Jupiter in the Constellation of Pisces (the fish piscatorial).

9. What does Matthew mean when he say that all this took place to fulfill what the LORD had spoken by the prophets?
10. What is Matthew trying to tell us about God's involvement in the history of the world?
11. How can we show our response to what Matthew tells us about the Christ?
