- A. Ultimately written by God Himself (God > Prophets > Apostles and Evangelists)
 - 1. 2 PETER 1:21
 - 2. Old Testament (before Christ)
 - 3. New Testament (after Christ)
 - 4. Chapters and Verses
- B. How We Got the Bible
 - 1. Oral Tradition
 - 2. Hebrew Old Testament
 - 3. Greek New Testament
- C. Criteria for Codification
 - 1. Written by a prophet
 - 2. Confirmed by acts of God
 - 3. Tells truth about God
 - 4. Comes with Power of God
 - 5. Accepted by People of God
 - 6. Points to the Messiah of God (John 1:1-3, 14)
 - 7. Triggers Relationship with God
- D. Two Messages of the Bible
 - 1. LAW ... Shows our Sin(s)
 - 2. GOSPEL ... Shows our Savior

THE MEANINGS OF LIFE AND DEATH IN THE BIBLE

- A. Two Greek words are translated LIFE.
 - 1. Bios (BIOlogical Life) John 10:10
 - 2. Zoey (Abundant Life) ... John 6:53-54
- B. Greek *Thanatos* (DEATH) in the Scriptures
 - 1. DEATH = No relationship with God
 - 2. State of inner conflict (guilt, loneliness, inadequacy, futility, fear, shame)
- C. HUMAN REASON (NATURAL) cannot generate *Zoey LIFE*
 - 1. Spiritual Blindness (2 Corinthians 4:3-4)
 - 2. Spiritually Dead (Ephesians 2:1-5)
 - 3. Spiritual Enemies of God (Romans 5:6-10)
- D. GOD DRAWS US INTO RELATIONSHIP THROUGH THE WORD
 - 1. First know the AUTHOR ... then the SOURCE.
 - 2. **JOHN 20:30-31**
 - 3. The WORDS of the WORD OF GOD have CONSEQUENCES.
