To Be a Disciple Unit 1101: The Disciple' and His / Her Worship and Piety Matthew 6:1-18

CONTINUITY FROM LAST SESSION (October 6, 2024)

- 1. Jesus elevates the Law to include *intentions of the heart*.
- 2. Perfect love for God and perfect love for the neighbor full the Law.
- 3. Love (giving what people need) must not be confused with Sentimentality (giving what people want).
- 4. Jesus has fulfilled the Law for us with His imputed perfect obedience to the Law.
- 5. Be sensitive to the difference between the Spirit of the Law ... and Letter of the Law.

I. THE NEW RIGHTEOUSNESS OF THE DISCIPLE IN WORSHIP

A. ALMSGIVING (Matthew 6:1-4)

- 1. ALMS: Something (such as money or food) given freely to relieve the poor and / or the distressed
- 2. The REWARD = Recognition by God ... not other people on earth
- 3. your Father ... Phrase occurs <u>9 times</u> in Matthew 6:1-18. (Father-Child)
- 4. trumpet ... Used to give a signal and draw attention
- 5. See Joshua 6:1-5
- 6 HYPOCRITE: ὕποκοιτής Originated in Greek theater (masked actor)

B. PRAYER (Matthew 6:5-15)

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- 1. PUBLIC PRAYER was part of the ancient synagogue worship service.
- 2. But NOT to gain a *reward of recognition* from other people.
- 3. Repetitious phrases ("many words") are an attempt to manipulate God.
- 4. Prayer is an act of dependence upon God not information giving.
- 4. Lord's Prayer is the MODEL PRAYER for the disciple.
- 5. Lord's Prayer is ESCHATOLOGICAL (points to the Last Thing)
 - a. Petitions 1-3 ask that God be honored and His will be fully recognized
 - b. Petitions 4-7 ask that God meet the daily needs of His disciples until Jesus comes again at the Last Day.
- 6. *hallowed be your name* Pray that God's Name be kept holy and is vindicated at the Last Day (See Ezekiel 36:22-23)
- 7. Your kingdom come God setting up His throne in human hearts ... today!

- 8. *our daily bread* Everything needed for support in body and life (See **Exodus 16:2-2, 13-21**)
- 9. forgive us our debts A common Jewish name for SINS
- 10. lead us not into temptation (See James 1:13-14)
- 11. deliver us from evil Greek says from the Evil One (Satan)
- 12. *if you forgive others their trespasses* extra reinforcement of the 5th Petition (See Luke 23:33-34)

C. FASTING (Matthew 6:16-18)

- 1. Voluntary abstaining from food in observance of religious need or event seeking enlightenment and deeper understanding.
- 2. Point: Fasting has to do with God not the person doing the fasting.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. What are the three traditional areas of Jewish piety [displayed righteousness] that were practiced by the disciples? Give a brief summary of each one.
- 2. What phrase occurs nine times in Matthews 6:1-18? What does the repeated use of this phrase suggest about a disciple's worship and piety?
- 3. What is the difference between the "reward" God gives the disciple and the "reward" that the hypocrite seeks through his / her religious practices?
- 4. What is the central thought of the Lord's Prayer?
- 5. What are the three parts of the Lord's Prayer and what do they deal with?
- 6. Which petition of the Lord's Prayer does Jesus select for additional comment? Why?
- 7. What do we learn from this section about our own worship life as disciples of Jesus?
- 8. How do you think we should practice our daily piety as disciples of Jesus? What should be INCLUDED?

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
