I. THE CALLING OF THE FIRST DISCIPLES (MATTHEW 4:18-22)

MATTHEW 4:18-22 <u>18</u> While walking by the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers, Simon (who is called Peter) and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea, for they were fishermen. <u>19</u> And he said to them, "Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men." <u>20</u> Immediately they left their nets and followed him. <u>21</u> And going on from there he saw two other brothers, James the son of Zebedee and John his brother, in the boat with Zebedee their father, mending their nets, and he called them. <u>22</u> Immediately they left the boat and their father and followed him.

II. JESUS PREPARES TO TRAIN HIS DISCIPLES [Matthew 4:23-25]

A. Three Messianic Expectations: ... teaching, proclaiming the Gospel, healing diseases

- 1. Jesus' fame spreads to Aram-Syria and the Decapolis (10 Towns)
- 2. Stage is set for DISCIPLESHIP TRAINING (Sermon on the Mount)

III. THE SERMON ON THE MOUNT [Be-Attitudes] Matthew 5:1-11

- A. Great revelations about Kingdom of God always take place on *mountains*.
 - 1. Sermon on the Mount begins with the BE-ATTITUDES (attitude determines altitude)
 - 2. Beatitudes fall into two units:
 - a. Beatitudes 1-4 (5:3-6)b. Beatitudes 5-8 (Matthew 5:7-10)
 - 3. Note the word *blessed* ($\mu\alpha\kappa\dot{\alpha}$ ριος) in all eleven of the Beatitudes ...
 - 4. Happiness that is knowable only by true disciples of Jesus.
- B. Essence of the Beatitudes
 - 1. Poor in spirit (repentance and dependance)
 - 2. Those who mourn (long for comfort because of sin)
 - 3. Meek (humble and trusting God)
 - 4. Hunger and thirst for righteousness (right relationship with God)
 - 5. Merciful (patient, gentle and forgiving)
 - 6. Pure in heart (undivided loyalty and devotion)
 - 7. Peacemakers (bring peace and harmony to the Body)
 - 8. Persecuted for Righteousness sake (endure ridicule even death)
