### Unit 1501: Ten Miracles Reveal the AUTHORITY of Christ – Part 2

Matthew 7:28-9:34

#### **CONTINUITY FROM LAST SESSION (October 27, 2024)**

- 1. Jesus calls twelve 'rookies' to be His disciples and engage in mission.
- 2. Matthew is a Jewish Rookie Disciple who wants to introduce OT Jews to Jesus.
- 3. Jesus performs 'boot-camp training' in the Sermon on the Mountain (Matthew 5-7).
- 4. Next Jesus gives 'crash course' on embracing His AUTHORITY (demand obedience).
- 5. Performs 10 (completion) MIRACLES that demonstrate AUTHORITY.

#### A. AUTHORITY MIRACLE #4: JESUS CALMS A STORM (Matthew 8:23-27)

- 1.SEA OF GALILEE was noted for sudden violent storms
- 2. PSALM 107:23-32
- 3. Jesus' has TOTAL AUTHORITY OVER NATURE

#### B. AUTHORITY MIRACLE #5: (3) JESUS EXORCISES TWO DEMONIACS (8:28-34)

- 1. Jesus is called SON OF GOD for first time in Gospel of Matthew.
- 2. Demons recognize Jesus' TOTAL AUTHORITY over Satan and demonic forces.
- 3. Two possible responses to Jesus Christ: (1) FAITH or (2) UNBELIEF

#### C. AUTHORITY MIRACLE #6: JESUS HEALS A PARALYZED PERSON (Matthew 9:1-8)

- 1. Disease and Paralysis are manifestations of sin's destructive power.
- 2. PSALM 38:3
- 3. The real issue here: JESUS HAS AUTHORITY OVER SIN ITSELF!
- 4. BLASPHEMY: Sin of a human claiming the place and power of God.
- 5. **LEVITICUS 24:16**

#### D. JESUS REVEALS HIS AUTHORITY WITH THREE METAPHORS (Matthew 8:9-17)

- 1. JESUS THE CALLER (Calls people out of sin and suffering)
- 2. JESUS THE PHYSICIAN (Heal SICK (infected) WITH SIN and sin-devastation
- 3. JESUS THE BRIDEGROOM (Bringer of IMMEDIATE JOY)
- 4. Jesus is NOT a new "patch" is sewn onto "old wineskins" of Israel's piety.

# E. AUTHORITY MIRACLES #7 and #8 : A GIRL RAISED TO LIFE and a WOMAN HEALED (Matthew 9:18-26)

- 1. RULER = (layman in charge of the local synagogue in Capernaum)
- 2. Account is interrupted by a woman with constant menstrual hemorrhage.
- 3. **LEVITICUS 15:19-25**
- 4. Jesus' authority over death shatter wall of ridicule and unbelief

#### F. AUTHORITY MIRACLE #9: JESUS HEALS TWO BLIND MEN (Matthew 9:27-31)

- 1. Son of David designation is AUTHENTIC MESSIANIC LANGUAGE (Matthew 1:1)
- 2. Jesus s not interested in 'putting on a show".

## G. AUTHORITY-MIRACLE #10: JESUS HEALS A MAN UNABLE TO SPEAK (Matthew 9:32-34)

- 1. PHARISEES accuse Jesus of exorcising demons through Satan's power.
- 2. Only two possible responses to Jesus and the Kingdom of God: a) Faith and fruit of Obedience to Authority b) Unbelief and fruit of Disobedience to Authority
- 3. The 10 MIRACLES OF JESUS are acts of SELF-REVELATION (Son of Man, Son of David and Son of God)

## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. How many miracles does Matthew record in this section? Significance of that number?
- 2. What do the first 3 miracles {Leper cleansed, Centurion Servant healed, Peter's Mother-in-Law} tell us about Jesus?
- 3. In the first interlude between the miracles, Jesus uses a title about Himself for the first time. What is it? What do you think it means?
- 4. How does Jesus deal with the two "volunteers" for the Kingdom of God? What is the point of his answers to these two men?
- 5. What does the second series of miracles (Still the Storm, Gadarene demoniacs, Paralytic forgiven and healed) teach is about Jesus? What are the miracles? Describe them briefly.
- 6. What is the point of the story about the healing of the paralytic? How does what Matthew stresses in the story effect us today?
- 7. In the second interlude between the miracles, Jesus is described with three terms. What are those terms and why do they apply to Jesus?
- 8. Matthew indicates that Jesus aroused the hostility of two groups in Judaism. Who are they?
- 9. The last four miracles (Woman with hemorrhage, Ruler's daughter raised, 2 blind men, dumb demoniac) show us something important about Jesus. What is the new term applied to Him by the blind men. What does it tell us about Jesus?
- 10. This entire section about the Authority-Miracles of Jesus shows us that there are only two possible responses to Jesus. What are they?
